

Replacing the button-type battery (included)

 ${m 1}$ Insert your finger nails into A and B on the diagram below, press A according to the direction, then pull out the battery holder.



 $\boldsymbol{2}$ Remove the old battery, then insert the new battery into the battery holder with the + side facing



Lithium battery (Cr2025)



Note:

To prevent leakage of fluid from the lithium battery, remove the battery when not using the remote control for a long time (one month or more). If the battery leaks fluid, carefully wipe it out of the battery case, then change a new one.

Precautions

- Please fully charge the battery before the first time.
- The battery may not recharge fully when it is in a hot environment.
- It's normal that the battery unit temperature is about 20°C higher than the surrounding temperature during a recharge.

Battery storage

- Please place the battery in a proper environment $(-5 \, ^{\circ} \, \mathbb{C} \, ^{\circ} \, \mathbb{C})$.
- Please recharge once a month if the battery is not used for a long time.

Battery life

■ The battery unit can be used for about 300 cycles of recharging and operations, though this is variable depending on the operating conditions.


Using the battery

- The picture may be unstable if the battery power is not enough.
- Please recharge the battery when the main unit is powered off. The battery recharge will take about 4 to 5 hours.
- When the battery power is depleted, OSD will show out"WARING LOW BATTERY".

Installing the battery

Please install the battery unit as following:

- 1. Attach the battery unit to the main unit.
- 2. Pull the lock button to left and right as follow arrow 1, until the battery unit is locked to the main unit.
- 3. Then the power LED indicator is light on.




Removing the battery

Please remove the battery unit as following:

- Turn off the main unit
 Press the battery lock key and pull down the battery unit, then the battery is removed.

Note:
Please turn off the player before installing and removing the battery.



Recharging the battery by using AC-DC adapter

Please recharge the battery as follows:


- 1 Install the battery
- 2 Connect the AC-DC adapter to the player
- When charging, the charge LED indicator lights up and keeps blinking. (Green)
- When the battery is full, the LED indicator is green.
- The charging time is around 4 to 5 hours. (Player is powered off)

Note:

- Please place the battery on a level, flat surface for recharging.
- Failure to do so may cause the battery short circuit.

Cautions

- The temperature during recharging affects the recharging efficiency.
- Recharging is most efficient between 0°C and 45°C.
- When the battery unit is hot, it may take longer than usual time to recharge it. Sometimes, it cannot be recharged when it's hot. Wait for the battery unit to cool down before recharging it.




Using the AC-DC adapter

Connect the power cord to the DC IN jack as shown in the illustration.

Note:

AC-DC adapter specification: 12V/1.5A Please use the adapter that is the standard accessory of the main unit.




Using the earphone

- Connect the earphone plug securely to the earphone jack on the main unit.
- Using +/- to adjust the volume.

Note:

Please do not play DTS disc. It will produce some strong noises.

Insert the earphones plug securely, otherwise sound will not be heard.




Connecting to USB storage

- The main unit can read the contents of USB storage when there is no disc in the main unit.




Connecting to memory card (SD/MMC/MS)

- 2 The main unit can read the contents in the memory card automatically



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
Connecting to a digital amplifier that has not Dolby Digital / DTS / MPEG compatible

Output the digital signals from the player's digital output to a digital amplifier that is no Doby/DTS / MPEG compatible.

Notes:

■ Carefully check the player's digital output settings before connecting the player to an amplifier which is not Dolby Digital / DTS / MPEG compatible.

Do not play DVDs when the audio settings are not correct. Or may cause strong noise and damage your speakers.




Connecting to a Dolby Digital / DTS / MPEG decoder or an amplifier with built-in decoder



Note:


- For a compatible decoder or amplifier,5 speakers (front left /right/center/surround left/right) and a subwoofer are required to enjoy Dolby Digital/5.1-channel sound.
- Before connecting, make sure to turn off the power of this DVD player, amplifier and TV.



Connecting to a Audio/Video player system



Playing discs



- 1 Install the battery or plug the AC-DC cord to DC IN jack.
- 2 Turn on the player.
- 3 Slide the disc cover and put in the disc.
- 4 Loading disc, the disc type will be shown on the screen.
- 5. Press PLAY to start playback.

- Please place the disc carefully
- Do not play poor quality discs to prevent damage from the lens.

Removing discs

- 1 Press STOP to stop playback.
- 2 Take out the disc.

Adjusting picture(Brightness/Contrast/Color/Sharpeness/Screen mode/Screen on/off)

Press P MENU to cycle through the TFT's menu as brightness, contrast, color, sharpeness, screen mode, screen on/off.

Basic operations

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Stopping playback

- 1 Press STOP to stop playback. The position is memorized.
- 2 Press PLAY to resume playback.
- 3 Press STOP again to fully stop playback of the disc.



Note:

- RESUME function only allows for DVD/VCD/CD (after playing 30 seconds)
- For MP3/JPG/JPEG, RESUME function is not available.

Pausing playback

- 1 Press PLAY/PAUSE to pause the disc when playback.
- 2 Press PLAY/PAUSE to resume playback.



Fast-forwarding/Fast-reversing

During playback, press REV or FWD to fast reverse or forward playback at X2, X4, X8, X20 and normal speed.



Hint: No sound during fast-forward/fast-reverse.

Slow and frame-by-frame playback

1 Press SLOW to slow playback at 1/2, 1/3, 1/4, 1/5,1/6,1/7 and normal speed.



Note:

- No sound during frame-by-frame playback.
- For CD/MP3, this function is not available.

Repeat playback

- 1 To repeat a title, a chapter or a track
- Press REPEAT to select a title, chapter or track during playback.
- DVD: title, chapter; VCD or CD: track.



Searching the disc

- Press GOTO during playback.
- Using cursor key to select the chapter or track.
 Input the numbers directly to specify the preferred chapter or track.

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■ Press ENTER to confirm.
■ Press GOTO to resume playback.




Program playback

The main unit may play the list according to the following program list:

1. Press PGM, the menu will be shown on the screen.

Hint:



Note: Some discs may not offer title, chapter or track numbers



2. Enter numbers by using cursor key to creat the list as shown in the illustration.



- 3. Using the cursor key to move the cursor to the PLAY icon, and press ENTER to start playing the list.
- 4. Using the cursor key to move the cursor to the CLEAR icon, and press ENTER to clear the play list.
- 5. Press PGM to exit program menu.

Note:

- ■The program list will be cancelled when the main unit is power off or eject the disc.
- ■The unit can not play the list if you select the item that does not exit in the disc.

Basic operations

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Using DISP/EPG

- 1. When in DVD mode, press DISP/EPG to display disc type, current title, current chapter and the playing time, press again to display the current subtitle language, the current audio language and the current angle number(during playback of a disc).
- 2. Press DISP/EPG for the third time to dectivate the information display.

Selecting subtitles

Press SUBTITLE to select the subtitle during DVD playback.



Note: With multiple subtitle language DVDs, the subtitle language can be switched during playback.

Selecting audio settings

- 1. Press AUDIO to select the audio language during DVD playback.
- 2. Press AUDIO to select the audio channel during VCD playback.



Selecting angles

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Press ANGLE to select the play angle when playing a DVD disc .





Playback of the files stored in the USB storage

3. To operate USB storage ,refer to MP3 ,JPEG disc operation for details . (page 33)

The MP3, JPEG, MPEG4 file can be played on this player.

Note:

■ The unit must be in no disc mode when play the file stored in the USB storage

Playback of the files stored in the Memory card

Please insert the card (SD, MMC, MS) in to the socket. The file will be played automatically.

- 1. Turn on the unit, connect the SD, MMC, MS card to the socket when the unit is in no disc mode.
- 2. "READ CARD" and the files will be displayed on the screen.



3. To operate Memory Card, refer to MP3, JPEG disc operation for details. (page 33)

The SD, MMC and MS can be read on this player.

Note:

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■ The unit must be in no disc mode when play the file stored in the card

Press SETUP when the main unit is in play mode. The set up menu will be displayed on the screen.

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Selecting a TV system (when you attached a TV tuner)

Setting screen saver



Setting parent lock

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- 1. Input old password (Default: 0000)
- 2. Press ENTER/PLAY on the remote control, when the screen displays open lock icon, then input new password.



3. Press ENTER/PLAY again, the screen will display close lock icon, the new password is memorized.

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Setting parent lock level

This setting can control the unit play parent lock DVD disc.

- Level is divided into 8 levels
- Default: ADULT

■ The parent lock level can not be set if the parent lock is locked.

Selecting an OSD language

Selecting digital audio output

- SPDIF/OFF: switching off digital audio output
- SPDIF/RAW: please set the audio output to RAW if you have a Dolby digital 5.1 or DTS capable amplifier.

- Default: SPDIF/PCM

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Adjusting the key

When you enter the KEY menu, you can use the cursor keys Λ / V to adjust the desired tone and press ENTER.



Adjusting the brightness

When you are in VIDEO SETUP, you can enter the BRIGHTNESS menu and move the cursor keys Λ / V to the desired brightness, then press ENTER.



Adjusting the contrast

When you are in VIDEO SETUP, you can enter the CONTRAST menu and move the cursor keys \bigwedge / V to the desired contrast, then press ENTER.



Adjusting the saturation

When you are in VIDEO SETUP, you can enter the saturation menu and move the cursor keys \bigwedge / V to the desired saturation, then press ENTER.



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Adjusting the sharpness

When you are in VIDEO SETUP, you can enter the SHARPNESS menu and move the cursor keys \bigwedge / \bigvee the desired sharpness, then press ENTER.



Troubleshooting

Problem	Remedy
No power	Insert the power plug securely into the DC IN jack.Recharge the battery.
No audio at Digital Output	Check the digital connections. Check if the audio format of the selected audio language matches your receiver capabilities.
The player can not play	 Disc may have been placed in the tray upside down. Player's region code should be the same as region code of DVD disc. Disc should be clean or the disc is scratched. This player cannot play discs other than supported by this player.
No sound	 Ensure that the equipment is connected properly and firmly into jacks. Make sure the speakers are turned on. If using a HiFi amplifier, try another sound source. Check the Volume Adjustment.
The remote control does not work	 Check the batteries are installed with the correct polarity (+ and -). The batteries are depleted: Replace them with new ones. Point the remote control at the IR receiver window and operate. Operate the remote control at a distance but no more than 5 meters from the IR receiver window.
